LABOR INVESTING FOR TOMORROW (LIFT) INTERNSHIP PROGRAM 2021

The Labor Investing for Tomorrow (LIFT) program was created by the Department of Labor in 1989 as a summer internship program to provide college level students with an on-the-job orientation in various professional fields.

LIFT is open to you if you are between the ages of 18 - 25, inclusive, presently in college and completed at least 60 credit hours, and have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.80. LIFT administrators have designed a highly competitive selection process for the program. Essays will be Content (30%), Organizational Development (30%), Mechanics (30%), and Style (10%). Applicants who have successfully passed the review process are then scheduled for interviews.

During the six (6) to eight (8) weeks of the LIFT Program, interns are paid \$13.00 per hour and are expected to work no more than 35 hours per week. Program participants are encouraged to practice and promote your skills, network, and utilize this opportunity to establish valuable contacts within your area of interest.

Interested juniors, seniors or graduate students must complete the LIFT application attached. Please email completed applications to <u>lift@vi.gov</u>, to the attention of the LIFT Coordinator, by the **April 16, 2021**, deadline. Copies of sensitive documents (social security card, birth paper, etc.) can be dropped off to our Youth Team at our St. Thomas and St. Croix offices by the deadline to be considered for the 2021 program or sent via **Certified Mail** to:
